### 1 Cancun, Mexico

Welcome at the Cancun airport by our representative and transfer by modern air-conditioned deluxe motor coach to your hotel.

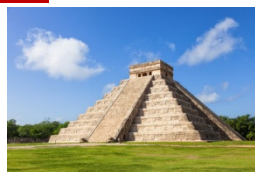
### 2 Cancun



Excursion to Xcaret, a private ecological park with recently excavated Mayan ruins and subterranean tunnels, water holes,

lagoons and beaches as well as exiting exhibitions such as the aquarium, sea turtles, Manati lagoon, bat cave, butterfly and bird cages, islands of deers, jaguars & pumas, monkeys, jungle trail, orchid garden among others. During the day shows of the Flyers of Papantla, the Ball Game and Mexican Charreadas are presented. Who is interested can also visit a Mexican graveyard or a real Mayan village. The major attractions are swimming and snorkeling through the subterranean river and swimming with dolphins (extra charge, reservations in advance are required). At night a folkloric show is presented, which belongs to the best in all Mexico. (B)

### 3 Cancun – Chichen-Itza – Merida



Travel from Cancun to Chichen-Itza (UNESCO World Heritage), the impressive ceremonial center of the Mayan

culture. Major points of interest are the Observatory, Pyramid of Kukulcan and the ball game court. Visit also the nearby Cenote Ik-kil, only about 2 km from

Chichen-Itza, also known as Holy Blue Cenote, round like a circle and open like a dwell in a tropical surrounding and small water falls. Here you can also take a bath. Then transfer to Merida. (B)

### 4 Merida – Uxmal – Merida

Tour of the so-called white city, visiting the Cathedral, the Museum of Anthropology and History, the Montejo Residence as well as the Zocalo, the market and Montejo Avenue. In the evening, tour to Uxmal, including the best Light & Sound Show in Mexico. Admire the impressive drama of the history of this amazing and fascinating people. After dinner, return to Merida. (B)



### 5 Merida → Mexico City

Morning transfer to the airport for your flight from Merida to Mexico City (**FLIGHT NOT INCLUDED**). On arrival welcome at the airport and transfer to the hotel for check in and rest. (B)

### 6 Mexico City

Tour to the Basilica of Guadalupe, the main centre of pilgrimage in Latin America. Then continue north of the city to the Pyramids of Teotihuacan, the largest discovered ancient Indian city of Central America. Remarkable are the Street of the Dead, the Citadel, the Temple of Quetzalcoatl, Sun- and Moon Pyramids. (B)



### 7 Mexico City



Panoramic City tour visiting the Reforma Avenue, the historic city centre with the main square, the Cathedral and the National Palace.

Afterwards drive through the Cha-pultepec Park and its residential areas. (B)

### 8 Mexico City → Home

Transfer to the airport for your flight back home as your trip comes to a end. (B)
